

WHO IS THE ROCK?

You've heard the phrase "Rock of Ages", right? Or perhaps not. Keep reading...

This post combines the answers to the questions:

"Who is the Rock", and

"What is the purpose of Prophecy".

Quick Recap...



In Daniel Chapter 2 of the Bible, Daniel had explained to King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon, the meaning of the magnificent statue, with each part representing the successive kingdoms of Babylon, the Medes, the Persians, and those that were to follow.

The prophecy covered an amazing period of far more than 1000 years.

(In these modern times with all the science, equipment, and brilliant algorithms, the weather stations can't even get next week's weather forecast exactly accurate!)



Daniel 2:34-35:

" ··· a rock was cut out, but not by human hands. It struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and smashed them.

Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver and the gold were all broken to pieces and became like chaff on a threshing floor in the summer. The wind swept them away without leaving a trace.

But the rock that struck the statue became a huge mountain and filled the whole earth."

Do you believe this?



You can safely believe it; it is the Truth.

...just as you can believe the prophecies in the Book of Daniel, which, over hundreds, and now a couple thousand years, have come true... (and some things still to come)

Luke 24:27






All Scripture is God-breathed, and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness 2 Timothy 3:16

Genesis 49:10




JOB

Job's prophecy came from at least 500 years before Jesus' birth!

Isaiah 52:7




ZECHARIAH

(Zechariah wrote this 500 years before Jesus was born...)

ISAIAH

(written 700 years before Christ's birth...)

"But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed." Isaiah 53:5

"He was oppressed and afflicted,
yet he did not open his mouth;
he was led like a lamb to the slaughter,
and as a sheep before its shearers is silent,
so he did not open his mouth."

PSALMS

Psalm 22:1




ISAIAH, and PSALMS

At the beginning of this post, I said it would combine the answers to the questions:

"Who is the Rock", and

"What is the purpose of Prophecy".

The prophecies in the Bible point to **Jesus**. From the beginning, we were pointed to Jesus and to the great plan of Salvation.

There is a great controversy that started in Heaven and is still ongoing – and God provided a plan of redemption, a way out and a way forward. You can read more about it in the post "Global Conflict".

Jesus says: "My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. You are my friends if you do what I command.

I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you."

John 15:12-15

...and from the great chapter where Jesus tells of "the sign of [His] coming and of the end of the age": Matthew 24,

"See, I have told you ahead of time." Matthew 24:25

The everlasting Kingdom of God

This is Jesus' Kingdom, and it is *ours* – finally restored to us, after we were cheated out of it through deception and lies in the Garden of Eden.

The Kingdom is built around/founded on the Rock, Jesus. He and our Heavenly Father share this wonderful Kingdom with us.

Now, why would the Infinite, the Most Holy, the Almighty, the Only Living God, awesome as He is - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – want to share with us, his people, his awesome Kingdom?

For the same reason this Loving God – who does not change – wanted to share it with us in the first place...



He *loves* us, and wants a *Relationship* with mankind... with *you*, with *me*!

This is the Loving God who knows your hairbrush is full of hair because you're stressed out!



This is the Loving God who – in the beginning – put mankind in charge of all Creation…

"God blessed them and said to them, 'Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky and over every living creature that moves on the ground.' Then God said, 'I give you every seed-bearing plant on the face of the whole earth and every tree that has fruit with seed in it. They will be yours for food.'"

Genesis 1:28,29

From Genesis through the entire Bible, all the way to the end of the Book of Revelation, prophecy pointed to restoration...

to our Loving God's plan to restore the good relationship that we had with Him before sin entered Creation, to restore to us the Kingdom lost, to restore to us our original Freedom and Peace, to redeem us through Jesus, the Christ; to restore the Lost and make everything New.

And it is so good, so beautiful, that we cannot even imagine it!

Revelation chapters 21 and 22 describe some of the features, and we get a sense of the magnificence...

"But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him."

1 Corinthians 2:9

Can this be true?

As with all the prophecies in the Bible...

as with all the promises in the Bible...

Jesus says: "...these words are trustworthy and true."

Revelation 21:5

The lovely words to a wonderful song say:



"There is a gate that stands ajar, And through its portals gleaming, A radiance from the cross afar, The Saviour's love revealing.

O depth of mercy! Can it be, That gate was left ajar for me? For me, for *me*? Was left ajar for me!"
